# **Maritime Occupations Exploration**

A Career Exploration Activity for High School (Grades 9-12)

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### **Purpose**

The goal of this SMART activity is to expose students to a wide variety of careers in the maritime and transportation industry. By exploring, comparing and writing about maritime careers as described online and in the SMART Maritime and Transportation Career Guide students will gain a broader understanding of the career opportunities, educational requirements, wages and daily tasks in the industry.

#### **Duration**

Three 45- to 60-minute class periods

#### **Process**

#### Day One Objective

The student will compare and contrast similar occupations in the marine industry and the commercial industry, i.e. Marine Electrician/ Commercial-Residential Electrician

### **Procedure**

The student will read the occupation featured as electrician in the SMART Center Maritime Career Guide & Resource Handbook under the Ship Maintenance and Repair Section and compare the occupation to the commercial or residential aspect of the same occupation. S/he will then complete the correlating worksheet, filling in the spaces matching various aspects of each occupation.
