

Creating a Product Label

1. Each team member will create a product label for their purified RFP.
Your label will not contain all of the information required by the FDA. But hopefully this assignment will get you thinking about what type of information should be on medical product labels.

2. Your label should be eye-catching but also easy to read.

3. You may use color and images.

For this assignment please feel free to use more color and images than you see on most of the label examples in the Creating a Product slide deck. Be creative!

4. Your label should contain the following information:
 - Product Name – Each team should create a name for their purified RFP (or GFP) product
 - Produced by: Team Name
 - Total Volume of purified protein:
 - Purified protein Concentration:
 - Storage: Store at 4 °C
 - Lot # - The Lot # should be RFP-Purification date-Team Name Abbreviation (not longer than 6 characters)
Example: RFP-08242022-PPP
 - Warning: For Research Purposes Only
 - Team Logo
5. Print or draw your product label out in a size of approximately 4 inches x 5 inches
